Parking

H-E-B Center at Cedar Park is equipped with 2,600 general parking spaces. Handicap parking spaces are available closest to the building. These spaces are limited and fill up fast, please plan to arrive early. The Valet parking lot will be used as a drop off / rideshare area only.



Parking Fee

- Cars, Pick-up Trucks, SUV's: \$5.75 in advance | \$6.00 day of
- Busses/Larger Vehicles: \$30 day of only
- Valet parking is not available during graduations and will be used for a drop off area



Entering H-E-B Center at Cedar Park

Hutto High School issued tickets are required for entry to H-E-B Center on the day of the ceremony. There are THREE (3) entrances into H-E-B Center. Entrances have been expanded to allow for more social distancing as a COVID-19 precaution. Locations are the East Main Entrance, South Entrance and North Entrance. Please reference the map below to understand the building entrances as they relate to the stage and graduate seating. Seating is first come, first serve. Please plan to arrive early for your preferred seating area.



Wheelchair Access and Limited Mobility Seating

General Seating Areas:

Wheelchair accessible and limited mobility seating areas are labeled on the above seating map with the ADA icon. The icons within the 100 Level sections are on the floor level. The icons on 200 Level Sections are on the loge level (2nd level) and are accessible by an elevator.

SPECIAL NOTE – access to all other non-wheelchair or limited mobility seating within the arena require the use of multiple steps!

- All entrances have ADA accommodations. Should you need to be seated on the loge level (2nd level); both North and South entrances have elevator access in the respective lobbies. The East Main entrance has an elevator southeast (to the left) of the entrance as you enter the building.
- Wheelchair and limited mobility seating is limited, so please arrive early should someone in your party require special accommodations.

Wheelchair Service, Hearing Assistance, and additional Assistance:

 Please visit the Guest Services Desk behind section 121 on the concourse to secure a wheelchair escort or assisted listening device. Please note both are first come first served and wheelchairs may not be kept during the ceremony. Wheelchair escorts will take you to and from your seating.

Additional Important Information

Seating:

- *Guests will not be allowed to save seats.* Please wait until your entire group is present before proceeding to sit down.
- A valid Hutto High School Graduation ticket will be required for entry into the facility.
- Guest Services Ushers will be available to assist finding seats as needed.
- Sitting in aisles is not permitted per the Cedar Park Fire Department.
- *REMINDER* The H-E-B Center at Cedar Park will NOT allow more than the maximum capacity of guests allowed inside the arena at any point of the graduations. Due to COVID-19, overall venue capacity has been reduced

Security:

- Please expect to go through a standard security screening process upon entering H-E-B Center at Cedar Park. The screening process includes a bag search (bags larger than 14"x14" and backpacks are NOT permitted), metal detection with walk-through magnetometers and hand-held wands.
 - Anyone refusing to participate in the security screening will not permitted to enter the facility.
 - If you are unable to go through a magnetometer, please let a security guard know and they will accommodate.
 - \circ $\;$ We strongly recommend the use of a clear bag to expedite the screening process.

Prohibited Items (Including, and not limited to):

- Weapons (knives, guns, pepper spray, fireworks, etc.)
- Noisemakers (air horns, whistles, rattlers, cowbells, thunder sticks and any other item that could distract others)
- Banners and/or flags
 - Signs are limited to a poster board size, 22"x28" the sign must not obstruct the view of the stage for other guests
- Balloons (helium, mylar, latex, etc.)
- Coolers
- Outside food and beverage
- Tripods, monopods, and selfie sticks
- Umbrellas larger than 12" in length

Food and Beverage:

 The venue's concessionaire, RS3, will be operating multiple concession stands that offer a wide variety of food and beverages available for purchase. For specific food offerings please visit our website http://www.hebcenter.com/plan-your-visit/arena-food-beverage

(NOTE: Some items may be unavailable due to COVID-19 precautions)

Smoking:

- There is NO smoking inside H-E-B Center at Cedar Park, including the use of electronic cigarettes, vapes and vape pens
- Designated smoking areas are on the north and south 2nd level loge balconies and the Craft Beer Corner & Patio **Strollers and Baby Carriers**:
- All strollers and baby carriers must be checked in at the Guest Services desk behind Section 121. They are not permitted within the arena seating.

First Aid:

- H-E-B Center at Cedar Park's first aid station is located behind Section 109 in the South Entrance lobby
- See an H-E-B Center at Cedar Park Guest Services or Security representative for additional assistance

Photography and Video:

- Photography and video are permitted during the ceremony, please note all camera bags will be searched upon entry
- Tripods, monopods, and selfie sticks are not permitted
- Remember to charge all batteries before coming to the ceremony, as there will be no place to plug in chargers

Cell Phones:

• Cell phones and other mobile devices can be very distracting and must be kept in silent or vibrate mode during the ceremony

Guest Services:

- The Guest Services desk is a great place to find out information, including help regarding lost guests in your party, hearing assistance devices, wheelchair services, and information about future events
- You can find the Guest Services desk behind Section 121 on the main concourse

Graduate Exits:

- We strongly encourage you to discuss an exterior post-ceremony meeting location with your graduate prior to the ceremony. Graduates will proceed out of the building immediately after the ceremony concludes.
 - Graduates will exit out our North and South Entrances depending on how they are seated on the floor.
- We recommend using the grass area outside of the East Main Entrance (front of the building) near the flag poles, reference image below. This will help you reconnect with your graduate faster!
- Practice social distancing while outside and reconnecting with your Graduate!

GUESTS

- ✓ Face Covering Required All guests must wear a cloth face mask to cover both nose and mouth upon entry. One-time use disposable masks are provided by H-E-B Center if the guest does not already have one.
- Elevator usage is limited to one party or one family at a time and will be disinfected after each use.
- ✓ Wash Hands for 20 seconds often. When needed, nine touchless hand sanitizing stations have been added to the office spaces and high traffic walkways.

FRONT OF HOUSE

- ✓ Fifty (50) hand sanitizing stations are available throughout entry points and concourse.
- ✓ Deep cleaning between events Fully sanitize arena seats and high touch point areas after every event with hospital grade disinfectant.
- Continuously cleaning during events Add additional housekeeping staff to continuously clean restrooms throughout the event to ensure all soaps and disposables are properly stocked.
- ✓ Social distancing & elevator etiquette signage posted throughout the arena.
- Social distancing floor markers at every line queuing (Box Office, Security, Restrooms, Concessions, etc.).
- Limiting elevator usage to one family or one party per ride and add guest services staff at elevators to disinfect after each usage.
- ✓ Turning off water fountains until further notice
- Limiting touchpoints by propping open interior doors when possible.



PARKING

- Employee PPE All parking employees must wear masks and gloves at entry points or when customer facing.
- ✓ Credit Card Only Cash is no longer accepted at lot entrances until further notice.
- ✓ Pre-Paid Mobile parking passes are offered online at <u>https://grs.lazparking.com/Widget/Simple/?I=76082</u>
- ✓ Valet Suspended Only self-park lots are available to customers until further notice.

GUEST SERVICES & SECURITY CHECKPOINTS

- ✓ Extending door times to 90+ minutes to allow plenty of time for guests to enter.
- ✓ Adjusting security screening lines to allow for social distancing.
- ✓ PPE all staff are required to wear facemasks and gloves at all times.
- ✓ Social Distancing Markers added for line queues at all three main entrances and added auxiliary entrance doors.
- ✓ Encouraging guests to use clear bags as H-E-B Center eventually shifts to a clear bag policy.

FOOD & BEVERAGE / CONCESSIONS

- ✓ PPE All RS3 employees must wear face masks and gloves.
- ✓ Social Distancing Queue lines with stanchion toppers or floor markers.
- ✓ Credit cards only Cash is no longer accepted at concessions until further notice.
- Removing all shared condiment & utensil stations and replacing with single use condiment packets and prepackaged utensils kept behind the concession stand counters.
- ✓ Offering more pre-packaged concessions.
